Our hope is to have the information flow back and forth, we need the help of the club contacts and callers to get the information to their club members, as well as providing information about their club to the newsletter publishers.






The ASDC board was approached about the possibility of having a clogging demonstration that would be done on the dance floor at one of the Central District dances. It was unanimously voted against at the June 3, 2013 ASDC board meeting. It is fine to do the clogging on a dance surface like plywood put on any of the carpeted area of the dance hall, but at no time is clogging allowed on the hardwood dance floor.

We understand that 30+ years ago clogging was allowed at the dance hall. Clogging and square dancing have a strong history and connection. Our floor today is 30+ years older - it has been sanded down the last time it can be sanded without hitting nails. We are trying to preserve it and are taking a cautious, conservative stance on this issue. It is nothing against clogging; it is a statement in favor of saving the floor we have so we do not have to replace it sooner than need be. The replacement figure for the dance floor is outrageous and it is **the asset** we have that attracts dancers and renters to our dance hall.

We thank you all for your continued support of the decisions made by the ASDC board and know that you will support us in this decision, too.


We have Mike Holly who is getting back into Calling he will be helping Horny Toad Bill Trent with the Crazy Eights. So please come out and help with this TRANSITION.

Hope to see you in a square soon.





When you come to the Square Dance Center in Albuquerque you have probably been asked "Are you a member of ASDC". When I first started dancing I had no idea what this meant, I had paid for the colored card but was told that was for NMSRDA. Okay, what was this I wondered. Long time area members know what these letters stand for, but new dancers are left to figure it out and depending on a person's learning curve or the amount a person dances will depend on how quickly one will figure out these acronyms. This is what I discovered and would like to share.

ASDC stands for <u>A</u>lbuquerque <u>S</u>quare <u>D</u>ance <u>C</u>enter. Its membership runs January to December. Membership dues are for the building, its upkeep, and general maintenance. For those who dance at the center, it is a really good thing to belong to the ASDC because it preserves the building we all love to dance in. If you are not a member of the ASDC, you pay a little extra each time you dance at the center.

NMSRDA stands for <u>New Mexico S</u>quare and <u>Round D</u>ance <u>A</u>ssociation. Its membership runs from State Festival to State Festival which usually is May to May. A small portion of the membership dues go to the state organization (NMSRDA) for administrative costs, but most goes back to each district to support the districts.
